

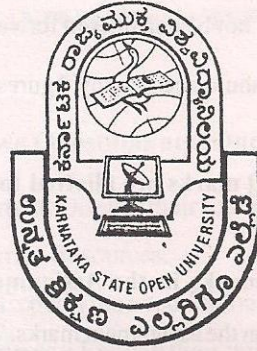

Instructions to students regarding submission of assignments

1. There are **nine courses** (including two practicals). Theory course assignment questions provided in this booklet. Practical assignment questions will be provided during the Personal Contact Programme.
2. Submission of two assignments in each course (including two practicals) by each student is compulsory.
3. **The assignments are to be submitted to Chairman, DOS in Library and Information Science, Karnataka State Open University (KSOU), Manasagangotri, Mysore – 570006, either in person or by registered post on or before 31-3-2012 without fail.**
4. Students are advised to submit assignments in legibly hand written form. Carbon copy of typed / written or photo copy of any form will not be considered for valuation.
5. Wherever necessary the assignment should accompany figures, charts and tables. References are to be given at the end of each assignment.
6. **Out of 100 marks in each course 20 marks are allotted for assignments and 80 are allotted for theory / practical examination.**
7. **Students must score 08 (EIGHT) marks in the Assignments of each course.**
8. There is no provision for improvement in the assignment marks. The marks once scored in the assignments are final and the same marks are retained if the student appears for subsequent examinations.
9. Attendance for contact programme and submission of assignment is compulsory.
10. Students are not allowed to appear for term-end examination, if they absent for PCP (personal contact programme) and if they fail to submit assignment on time.
11. **The student should write his/her Name, Enrollment number, Course, Subject and Phone number and Date of Submission on the Cover of Assignment while submitting the Written Assignment to the University. While submitting the Original Written Assignments to the University student should preserve the photo copies of all the assignments.**
12. In case, failing to submit hand written assignments, such candidates are not eligible for the completion of this programme. After getting admission to the university, the student must submit his/her Written Assignments.
13. **Assignments should be submitted during the year of admission only. Assignments submitted in subsequent years will not be accepted.** Student should keep the acknowledgement for having sent/submitted all the written assignments to the **Dr. J. Shivarama, Co-ordinator in Libray & information Science, Department of Studies and Research, Karnataka State Open University, Manasagangotri, Mysore-570 006.**
